"If they were all written..." John 21:25 (NLT)

In John 21:25 John wrote, **"There are many other things Jesus did. If every one of them were written down, I suppose the whole world would not be big enough for all the books that would be written" (21:25).**

John was an eye-witness of the miracles Jesus performed while on earth. John saw first-hand the healing of those who were sick, lame, blind, cripple, and mute. He saw the love and compassion Jesus had for those who were lost, sad, lonely, and heart-broken. He was able to see the grace, mercy, and forgiveness as he people came to him confessing their sins, falling at his feet in repentance.
