In 1 Peter 1, Peter ends this part of the letter by telling us that the "word of the Lord will live forever. And this is the word that has been preached to you." This "word" is the teaching about Jesus; his commands, his life, death, his good news that has withstood the test of time and has transcended it.

Over the years, we have been blessed by technology. It's because of technology that we have been able to print this "word" and all of the different translations into one book; the Bible, which means the Book. Furthermore, not only has the Bible been printed into "book" form, but you can read it on-line using different web-sites on the computer or by downloading different applications on your smart phone as well. It's because of this technology that it's becoming more common to see someone scrolling through the digital "scrolls" during Bible class or while following along a sermon.

Peter continues in his letter by saying, "As newborn babies want milk, you should want the pure and simple teaching" (2:2a). This "pure and simple teaching" is the teaching that is found in the word of God, which is about the Word of God; Jesus. And Peter makes it clear that as a newborn wants milk to live, grow, satisfy his/her hunger, that's how we should want the word of God. But do we want it?

Sure there are a lot of things we want, but do we want God's word more than any of these? If we do, then we will take advantage of our technology and read and study it. If we don't, then, just like a baby who never gets the milk he/she needs will be malnourished or die, so will we. If we don't commit our lives to reading and studying God's word, we will never grow in our relationship with Jesus, we will always be malnourished and that relationship will die.

I hope we will take advantage of the technology that allows us to have multiple copies and translations of the Bible. But most of all, I hope that we sincerely want to read it because "By it you can grow up and be saved, because you have already examined and seen how good the Lord is" (2:2).
