# **Everything He Does is Wonderful**

Mark 7:37

In Mark 7:31ff, a deaf man with a speech impediment was brought to Jesus to be healed. I am sure by now, you know how this story ends. If you guessed that the man was healed, you are right. But the reaction of the crowd is what gets to me.

After the man was healed, Jesus was very clear, he didn't want them to tell anyone, "but the more he told them not to, the more they spread the news" (v. 36). Have you ever been so overwhelmed by something so amazing that you were about to explode? We see amazing things happen in sports all of the time, don't we? Maybe it's a great catch in a game or an unbelievable dunk or wild lay-up. Perhaps a record has been broken or the team expected to win gets upset by an unlikely opponent. Whatever it is, news like this spreads quickly and it's all anyone can talk about for weeks and sometimes years.

This is the kind of thing that happened when Jesus healed the deaf man who couldn't speak. It is such an amazing thing for the crowd to have witnessed, they couldn't stop talking about it. In fact, the crowd joyfully proclaimed, "Everything he does is wonderful!"

I believe this crowd got it right! I also believe Jesus still does amazing things everyday too. Maybe it's not like healing someone, but the fact you and I woke up to worship this morning is a gift and to me, that is amazing enough. But think of all of the other wonderful blessings you've been given just in the short time you've been reading this article.

As we go through this week, may we be thankful for the things that Jesus does that are both big and small. Like this crowd, may we continue to be amazed and tell others, "Everything he does is wonderful."
