Deuteronomy 4:6-9

"Listen, Israel! The LORD our God is the only true God! So love the LORD your God with all your heart, soul, and strength. Memorize his laws and tell them to your children over and over again. Talk about them all the time, whether you're at home or walking along the road or going to bed at night, or getting up in the morning. Write down copies and tie them to your wrists and foreheads to help you obey them. Write these laws on the door frames of your homes and on your town gates" (CEV).

The above text was the command for Israel, the whole nation, to love God and teach their children to do the same, daily. Reading through a book called "Sticky Faith: Everyday Ideas to Build Lasting Faith in Your Kids" by Dr. Kara E. Powell and Dr. Chap Clark, there is one thing that it is evident; while parents are the most influential people in a child's life, the church must help families to be as influential as possible. In order for this to happen, the whole church needs to see our families and children as a mission field if we want to instill a faith in our kids that will "stick" for the rest of their lives.

In the forward of "Sticky Faith", John Ortberg and Jim Candy write, "Most kids lack connection to and investment from a church community that is mobilized to reach them. Very few churches have transformed their culture to see kids as a mission field on their own campuses" (p. 10).

What does this mean for the Bayfield church? This means we, the whole church, must continue to teach our kids to love God and keep his commands, daily. It means the whole church must do whatever possible to connect and invest ourselves into our kids. It means the whole church must transform our culture as a church to reach our kids in a culture that is always changing. It simply means, the whole church must see our kids, infants through twenty-somethings, as a mission field.
