A Little Water

There is something that didn't take me long to notice from living in Colorado; its dry. I have also picked up on that the word 'moisture' is often said in prayers as a result of the dry, drought that we will face in the coming seasons. All that said, when we do get the moisture, just a little can go a long way. It's like with the grass in the yard, just a little bit of water can make a huge difference, and the dry, dusty, deserts we call a yard, begin to grow again.

In John 4, there is a woman whose life, is a dry, dusty, wasteland. Then she meets Jesus at the well who says, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give will never be thirsty. The water I give will become a spring of water gushing up inside that person, giving eternal life" (v.13-14).

The result of this interaction with Jesus, is the life of the woman totally changes. Her life goes from being a wasteful, sinful life of adultery to one that has meaning, purpose, and growth. It's amazing what a little "living water" can do isn't it? Just like a yard becomes green from just a little rain, after one conversation with Jesus, this woman's life was forever changed.

So maybe you are reading this and your life seems a little dry or you are just in a dusty drought. Could it be you need just a little water? If so, let me encourage you to pray and drink deep from the scriptures. Take some time to read through one of the gospels and learn as much as you can about Jesus.

If a little "living water" can change the life of the woman in John 4, I know it will do the same for you.
