Have you ever seen your kids do something that made you think to yourself, "What were they thinking?" Whatever the thing was your son or daughter did, you knew that it was the exact opposite of what you wanted them to do, yet they went ahead and disobeyed you anyway.

In 1 Corinthians 13:11, Paul says, "When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I stopped those childish ways." I've often wondered why Paul would write this, just after he gives us one of the greatest teachings on love. In the text, Paul is pleading with the Christians in Corinth to desire love over anything else. I believe Paul wants the same for today's Christians.

But what's with the one sentence "rant" about putting away "those childish ways?" I've come to this conclusion, children don't really understand love. For kids, teens, some adults, the idea of love is foreign. I can't tell you how many times I've heard someone say, "I love you" to someone and in the very next breath say they love McDonalds. Or someone says "I love you" to someone else, yet gossip about them. And if you consider the rate at which people are getting divorced these days, I have a hard time believing that people really understand what love is

So what is love? Paul wrote in verses 4-7, "Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous, it does not brag, and it is not proud. Love is not rude, is not selfish, and does not get upset with others. Love does not count up wrongs that have been done. Love is not happy with evil but is happy with the truth. Love patiently accepts all things. It always trusts, always hopes, and always remains strong."

I'm not a professional on love but I believe Paul gives us a pretty good definition of what love is. And if you take each of these and apply the opposite to them, we would find what love is not.

Children are some of the most unloving people I know. They tend to be the least patient, jealous, rude, and selfish. But what about us? As "children of God" are we any different. Remember, Paul is writing this letter to *Christians* in the Corinthian church.

If we are being impatient, jealous, bragging, rude, selfish, getting upset w/ others, keeping lists of wrongs, we are not being loving. Furthermore, I would suggest if we are being any of these things, not only are we not being loving, but we are acting like children.

God gives us the example in Jesus for what love looks like when it is put into action. Paul gives us a good definition for what love is. Yet, I've often wondered how many times God has just looked at us and has thought to Himself, "What are they thinking?"

In his book "Crazy Love" Francis Chan challenges us by saying, "My suggestion as you think, make decisions, and discern how God would have you live is to ask yourself, "Is this the most loving way to do life?"

Perhaps it's time for us to reconsider what love really is and grow up a bit. Are we loving the way God wants us to, or are we just acting like children in our speech, thinking, reasoning, and in the way we love? If not, my prayer is that we will become the men and women God wants us to be, life live more loving, and stop our childish ways. ~ Brian
