I Will Never Be Shaken

Psalm 62:2

There are things that happen in our lives that can shake us up a bit. Things like, losing a job, a loved one, a car wreck, having a baby, a divorce, etc. These things sometimes shake us up so much, that it seems our lives begin to come unraveled, leaving us feeling insecure, skeptical, cynical, and unwilling to trust.

King David knew these feelings all too well. Although he was a great king, his life was shaken up often as he was running from a jealous King Saul. It would have been easy to lose hope, feel insecure, and become skeptical. Perhaps, as we read through the Psalms, we see some of that from David. But then there are those psalms, where we see a confident David.

Psalm 62, David writes, "I wait quietly before God, for my victory comes from him. He alone is my rock and my salvation, my fortress where I will never be shaken." Even when it seemed David had lost all hope and was in bitter despair, he would boast, "I will never be shaken." Why? Because he knew he was protected by the Mighty Fortress, God.

When David's life was shaken up a bit, he drew strength from the Lord. When David felt hopeless, he trusted in his Rock. When David needed protection, he retreated to his Fortress.

When our lives seem uneasy, as if the ground below seems unsure, let us follow the example of David and put our trust in our Lord and never be shaken.
