Don't Settle for Stones

Have you ever wondered why God's sends us into trials or allows us to be tempted? This is not to say that God is tempting us but he certainly allows it to happen. We've all been there. We have gone through trials and have fought temptations and there have even been those times when we have wondered why God allowed us to go through it.

When this happens, we must not see this as some sort of bad karma as the world of "pop religion" would believe nor should we see this as God punishing us for our disobedience. In his book "Uprising- A Revolution of the Soul", Erwin McManus explains that when we face trials and temptations "we shouldn't see this as punishment from God, but the process of God." And that process is God's way of making us into the people he longs for us to be.

In **Matthew 4:1ff**, Jesus was "led by the Spirit into the wilderness and was tempted" (v. 1). This was God leading his Son in an offensive attack against Satan. Satan didn't ask for this or bring this on, God simply allowed Jesus to go through this trial and be tempted.

Three times in three different ways, Jesus was tempted. First, after fasting for forty days and nights, Satan tempts Jesus to turn stones into bread (v.4). Second, Satan tempts Jesus to test God (vs. 5-6). Finally, Satan tempts Jesus by giving him everything the world has to offer if he will bow down and worship him (vs. 8-9). But no matter what Satan threw at Jesus, Jesus used the word of God to resist temptation and was able to get through this trial.

So, as we look at this passage of scripture, we must ask what can we learn from this. First, we must realize that God is going to allow us to be tempted and that there is no trial without temptation. Second, we must understand it is never God's plan to make us fail but to make into who he wants us to be. God longs for us to be in a relationship with Him, for us to seek Him, and to fully depend on Him. Satan seeks to destroy us and tear us away from God, but God wants us to live Him. Only when we live for God, are we living the life God has always intended us to have. John 10: 10 says, "The thief only comes to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life and have it to the full." Third, anytime we give into the temptations of Satan we are settling for less.

Look again at the three ways Jesus was tempted. Anytime we fail to worship God only, we are settling for less and are worshipping false idols. Anytime we test God instead of acknowledging that God is the Almighty, Father in heaven and His will and plans are better than ours, we are settling for less. Finally, anytime Satan tempts us to take care of our physical needs the way we want to, we are no longer eating "the bread of life", which is Jesus Christ, rather all we are eating are stones and again are settling for less.

So, may we realize that God is sending us into the wilderness to be tried and tempted so we can be who he wants us to be. May we always stand strong with God and His word so we will persevere and make it through these trials. May we never settle for anything less than God's full, abundant life. Finally, may we stop eating the stones that Satan offers us and always eat the "bread of life", which is Jesus Christ. ~ Brian
